(1) Write a short note on windows 10 ?

Answer: Windows 10 is a series of operating systems developed by Microsoft and released as part of its Windows NT family of operating systems. It is the successor to Windows 8.1, released nearly two years earlier, and was released to manufacturing on July 15, 2015, and broadly released for the general public on July 29, 2015.

(2) What is the Aero Peek feature ?

Answer: Windows Aero Peek (also called Desktop Preview) is a cool new feature in Windows 7 that lets you “sneak” a preview of windows that are on your taskbar so you can more easily sift through the multitude of windows you use daily.

(3) What are the virtual desktops? Explain.

Answer: A virtual desktop is a computer operating system that does not run directly on the endpoint hardware from which a user accesses it.

Virtual desktops are accessible through client software installed directly on an endpoint, which presents the desktop to the user and allows them to interact with it using a keyboard, mouse, touchscreen and peripherals.

Windows+Ctrl+D: Create a new virtual desktop and switch to it.

Windows+Ctrl+F4: Close the current virtual desktop.

(4) Which characters are used to locate files or folders, In case you know only a part of the file name? Explain with the help of examples,

Answer: If you only know part of the name of a file or folder you are searching for, you can use wild cards such as “*” or “?”. The asterisk can replace a whole group of letters or numbers, while the question mark only replaces one character. For example, typing “books. *” in the search box will find files such as books.
