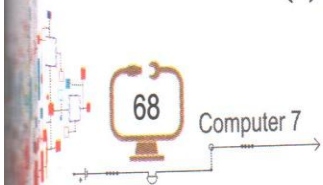

- Alternate text is also very accommodating in case images on a page cannot be found.

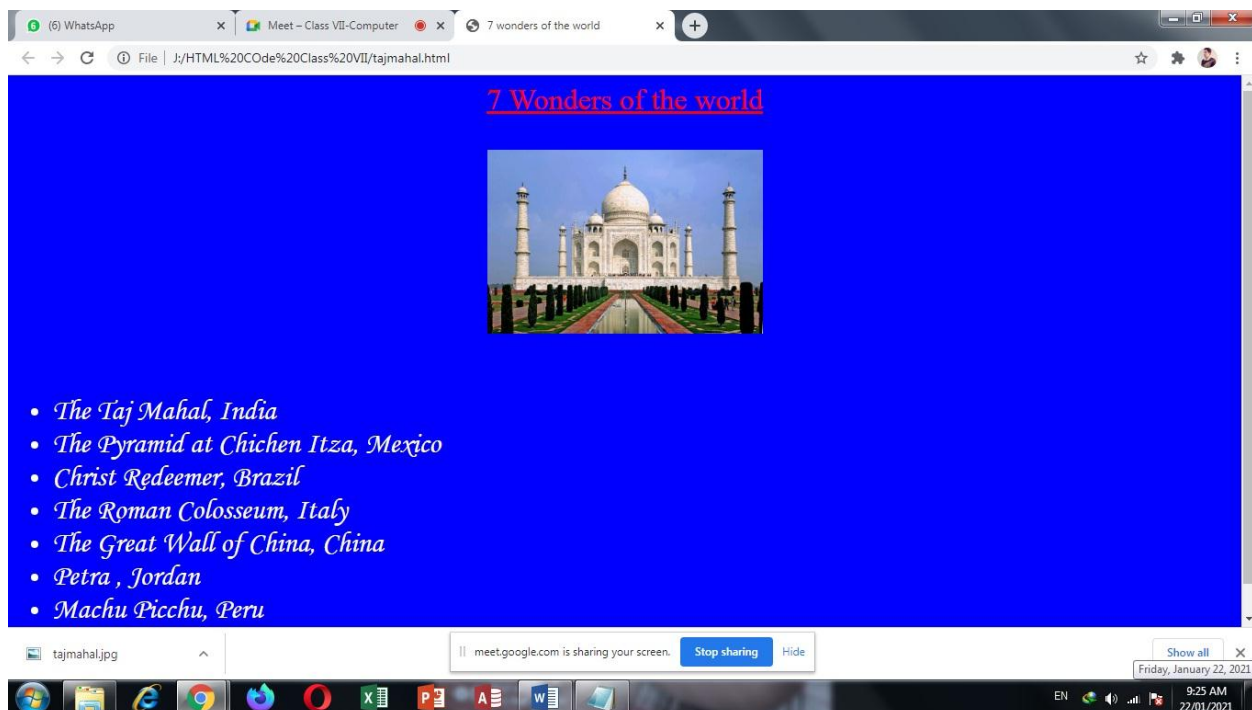
