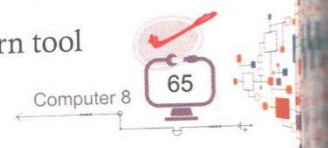

Question and Answer:

1. How is Healing Brush Tool different from the Spot Healing Brush Tool?

Answer:

The main difference between Spot Healing Brush and the normal healing brush is that the spot healing brush requires no source point. Whereas, the Healing Brush needs a source point.

2. What is the purpose of the Clone Stamp Tool?

Answer:

The Clone Stamp tool paints one part of an image over another part of the same image or over another part of any open document that has the same color mode. You can also paint part of one layer over another layer. The Clone Stamp tool is useful for duplicating objects or removing a defect in an image.

3. What is the use of Type tool? How will you insert text in an image?

Answer:

The Type Tool is one of the powerful tools in Photoshop, which is mainly a graphics editing program. It is the tool used to create text inside Photoshop, and it has plenty of settings to control the created text's properties.

On the Insert tab, in the Text group, click Text Box, click anywhere near the picture, and then type your text. To change the font or style of the text, highlight the text, right-click it, and then select the text formatting you want on the shortcut menu.

4. What do you understand by layers?

Answer:

In graphics software, layers are the different levels at which one can place an object or image file. In the program, layers can be stacked, merged, or defined when creating a digital image.

5. What are the steps to rename a layer?

Answer:

=> Open the file in Photoshop CS5 that contains the layer you wish to rename.

=> Click the layer once to highlight it in blue.

=> Double-click the layer name to open an editing field, then type in the new name for the layer. You can press Enter on your keyboard when you are finished.
