- The World Wide Web (WWW or W3) is a system of interlinked hypertext documents accessed via internet.
- E-commerce stands for Electronic Commerce which simply means the sale and purchase of goods and services on the internet.
- Using e-banking, one can check the amount, make FD (Fixed deposit), transfer the money, apply for loans and so on.
- E-mails are like letters sent from and to a computer through the Internet.
- An e-mail address consists of a Username and a Domain name.
