Adobe Photoshop is a powerful application for almost any kind of image editing and creating high quality graphics.

features of Photoshop :-

- (i) user friendly interface.
- (ii) take less time for editing.

The foreground color is used to draw, paint, spray or type. The background color is used for gradient fill and for filling the erased areas of an image.

(3) what are the differences between Marquee and Lasso tools?

marquee tool is used to select an image or part of it in a rectangular, square, elliptical or circular shape.

Lasso tool is a bunch of three very useful tools used for selecting irregular shapes.

④ what options appear on the options bar for the magic wand tool?

The magic wand tool is used to set various options for specifying the exact selection in the options bar.

These options include:

(1) Tolerance.

It determine how closely colours should be matched.

(2) Anti-aliased.

define a smooth edge for the selection.

(3) Contiguous.

select only adjacent areas that share the same colours.

⑤ write the steps to copy a selected portion of an image to the same image at another location:

steps are :-

- (i) select a part of an image using any selection tool.
- (ii) click on the move tool.
- (iii) hold ALT key and click and drag selection to a different location.
- (iv) click ok.
